



**AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION
BETWEEN
DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACOLOGY & PHARMACY,
THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG
AND
SCHOOL OF PHARMACY,
NATIONAL CHENG KUNG UNIVERSITY**

Department of Pharmacology & Pharmacy, The University of Hong Kong and School of Pharmacy, National Cheng Kung University hereby mutually agree to enter into an academic, educational, and cultural exchange agreement as follows:

1. Areas of Collaboration:

- (a) To the reciprocal exchange of faculty, staff, and students
- (b) To engage in joint research projects
- (c) To foster the exchange of academic publications and information, and
- (d) To promote other academic activities.

For the sake of active exchanges according to the agreement both universities will discuss further details before carrying out each exchange activity.

2. Use of Names, Marks or Logos

Neither party shall use the other party's name, marks, or logo and/or any names that is likely to suggest that it is related to the other party in any advertising, promotion or sales literature without first obtaining written consent of the other party.

3. Liability

Neither party shall be responsible to the other party for any punitive or special damages, indirect or consequential loss or damages or similar, such as, but not limited to, loss of profit, loss of revenue or loss of contracts.

4. Applicable Law

All research, teaching and other activities conducted under this Agreement must be conducted in accordance with the laws, rules, and regulations applicable to each Party. In the case of National Cheng Kung University, these are the laws, rules, and regulations of National Cheng Kung University and Taiwan. In the case of The University of Hong Kong, this will be conducted in accordance with the laws, rules, and regulations of Hong Kong SAR.

5. Dispute

If any disputes arise out of this agreement, the parties agree to seek non-litigious means to resolve them. The Head of Department of Pharmacology and Pharmacy at The University of Hong Kong and Chair of School of Pharmacy, Institute of Clinical Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences at National Cheng Kung University, or their designees, shall attempt to resolve any dispute or misunderstanding through collaboration.

6. Data Security

Both parties agree to keep all students' data in strict confidence, and use them solely for the purpose of the exchange programme.

7. **Assignment**
This agreement may not be assigned by either party without prior written consent of the other Party.
8. **Force Majeure**
The parties agree that, if by reason of strike or other labor disputes, civil disorders, severe weather, acts of God, government issued travel warnings or alerts, or other cause beyond the control of the party seeking to invoke this paragraph, either party is unable to perform entirely its obligations, such non-performance shall not be considered a breach of this agreement.
9. **Renewal, Termination and Amendment**
This agreement shall take effect on the date of signing and shall remain in effect through the conclusion of 5 years unless sooner terminated by either party giving notice to the other party in writing no later than the end of March in any year that the agreement will be terminated prior to the commencement of the following year. The agreement may be extended or otherwise amended only by mutual written agreement signed by both parties. Any such amendments, once executed by both parties, will become part of this agreement.
10. Two (2) copies of the agreement will be signed in English, and both copies are recognized as formal documents.
